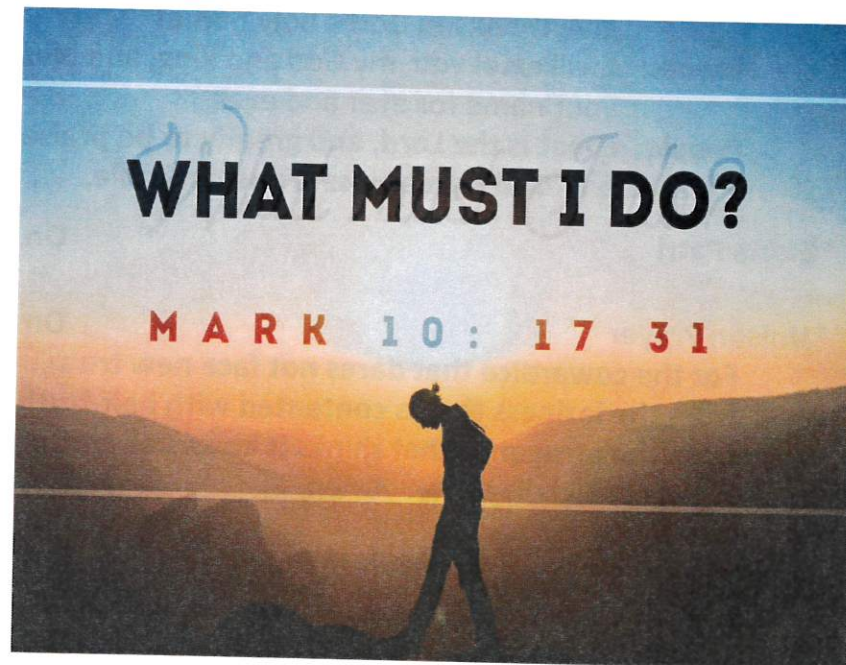

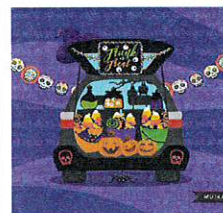
Continue to save your receipts through December 25. There is a collection box on the table in the back of the sanctuary.
